



If you normally pay for NHS dental treatment, there will be three standard charges. The amount you pay will depend on the treatment you need to keep your teeth and gums healthy.

You will pay one of three charges below: [Revised December 2021]

- Examination, diagnosis and preventative care £23.80
- If necessary, this will include X-rays, scale and polish, and planning for further treatment.
Urgent and out-of-hours care will also cost £23.80
- Fillings, root canal treatment or extractions £65.20
- This charge includes all necessary treatment covered by the £23.80 charge
PLUS additional treatment such as fillings, root canal treatment or extractions.
- Crowns, dentures or bridges £244.30
This charge includes all necessary treatment covered by the £65.20 and £56.30 charges
PLUS more complex procedures such as crowns, dentures or bridges.

You will pay one charge even if you need to visit more than once to complete a course of treatment. You will be asked to pay for your treatment at the end of your first visit of each course of treatment.

Repairs to dentures will remain free of charge.

If you are exempt from NHS dental charges, please let our receptionist know when booking your appointment and have evidence available to show the receptionist when you arrive for your appointment.
